WARNING

- 1. All installations must be in accordance with the National Electrical Code, and any other applicable state and local electrical requirements.
- 2. Do not remove ground pin. Severe electrical shock could occur.
- 3. Check with local codes for proper installation.

Installation Instructions for 1 1/2" pipe.

- 1. Review figures 1,2,3 and 4.
- 2. Attach Oil Smarte Pump Switch to Quick Mount Bracket using #10 screws and nuts provided (See Figure 1).
- 3. Snap bracket onto discharge pipe or float tree pipe (See Figure 1).
- 4. Locate pump switch sensor rod at shut-off height 2" above the pump (See Figure 3 or 4).
- 5. Place hose clamp on pipe under quick mount bracket (See Figure 1) for reference location of the pump switch.
- 6. For easy maintenance, just snap bracket off and back on using the hose clamp as a guide.
- 7. Mount pump switch clear of inlet water and at least 1" to 2" from any metallic material.

Installation Instructions other than 1 1/2" pipe.


- 1. Use the universal PVC bracket and clamp provided.
- 2. Insert hose clamp through top of bracket. (see figure 2)
- 3. Mount Oil smart pump switch to universal bracket using # 10 screws and nuts provided.
- 4. Attach Oil Smart Pump Switch with "off" rod 2" above the top of the pump (See Figure 3 or 4).
- 7. Mount pump switch clear of inlet water and at least 1" to 2" from any metallic material.

Maintenance

- 1. Plastic switch case and metal sensor leads must be kept clean, free of corrosion, mud, soap. Clean switch every four months or as often as environmental conditions dictate.
- 2. Clean with oil base product like kerosene, solvent or WD40. Do not use soap.





Oil Present Condition


short sensor detects oil.


The pump will not cycle if oil is in contact with the short sensor.
