
Color Variation Over Time

Wood reacts to ambient light. Most exotic wood species will become darker and richer over time with exposure to sunlight. The most dramatic changes occur within the first six months after installation.

Strips equalize the level between different flooring surfaces.



Combination Base/Shoe
Covers the expansion space between
the floor and the wall.



Quarter Round

Covers the expansion space between the floor and a wall.



Baby ThresholdCovers the expansion space at a threshold or sliding door.



T-MoldingCovers the expansion space between two equal height flooring surfaces.



Stair NosingCovers the expansion space on stair edges and provides a finished trim.
