Triple-Action Protecsol®

Ground breaking "intelligent" surface complex treatment which adapts the sliding coefficient of the sports flooring according to the type of action or movement! It ensures perfect footing and adherence when required in movements such as rapid acceleration and also increases the ease with which the sportsperson can pivot and slide. Triple-Action Protecsol® also virtually eliminates the risk of friction burns by reducing the temperature generated and its duration. Lastly, Triple-Action Protecsol® means that maintenance is greatly facilitated.





③ CXP[™] foam backing

A revolutionary process in foam backing manufacturing — Cellular Xtreme Process. This optimisation of the size and shape of the closed cells quarantees the sportsperson even greater comfort and safety without compromising indentation or secure footing.





2 D-Max™ surface complex

The new D-Max™ surface complex is the result of a unique process whereby calendared and pressed PVC layers of different densities are combined with a reinforced non woven fibreglass grid to produce a highly resistant surface layer. This provides even greater indentation resistance and shock absorption while increasing the overall durability of the surface complex.

The characteristics of an outstanding sports floor...



Shock absorption

This is the ability of the floor to absorb the energy from any type of impact such as jogging, running, jumping and of course falling or diving. This does not however measure the comfort of the floor. The latter is related to the nature of the material and its ability to deform and compress around the point of impact. It is for this reason that, in general, point-elastic floors tend to more comfortable than area-elastic floors.



Uniform friction

It is vital for a sports floor to have uniform friction in all directions on a sports floor. This not only increases the playability of the floor, but also reduces the risk of injuries such as sprains or twisted ankles.



➤ Ball bounce

This determines the playability of a sports floor. The higher the ball bounce percentage the better the floor. However, an important aspect of ball bounce that is not taken into consideration is the regularity of the bounce. A good sports floor has identical ball bounce in all areas and all across the floor.



Energy return

This determines the performance factor of the floor.

If the performance is low this is akin to running in sand.


On the contrary, if the performance is very high this would be like playing on a trampoline. A balance between these two extremes is required to ensure optimum playability and safety.



Resilience

This is the ability of the floor to spring back to its original shape.
