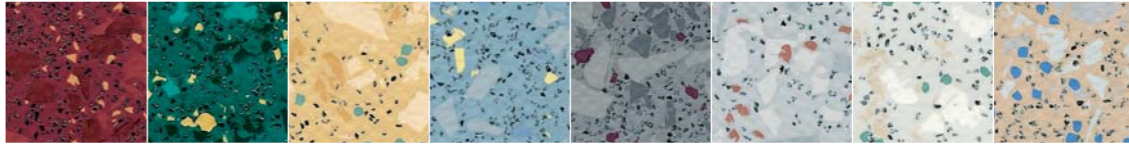

Safety, practicality and hygiene are key factors to consider when selecting floorcoverings in areas where food is prepared, served and sold. The look and feel makes a huge contribution to the success of these areas and students and staff will appreciate designs which are both visually stimulating and comfortable. Kitchens are very prone to high levels of contamination and need to be selected with the maximum of slip resistance to prevent accidents.

Staff rooms and common rooms often have vending machines and again safety flooring is recommended for areas where tea and coffee spills are likely to present a hazard.

Administration areas often have raised access floors and the flooring should be selected to ensure rapid access to vital services.

Key selection criteria:

- Safety – areas where floors are likely to be contaminated by water and other ingredients need to minimise the incidence of slip accidents. Clients need to be assured that appropriate materials are selected in all areas of danger to comply with the HSE's recommended good practice in regard to reducing slip accidents
 - Easy to clean surfaces
 - Comfort underfoot and noise attenuation
 - Compatibility with other materials including carpet tiles
 - Are suitable for use with raised access floors
 - Low maintenance costs
 - Neutrals and natural effects

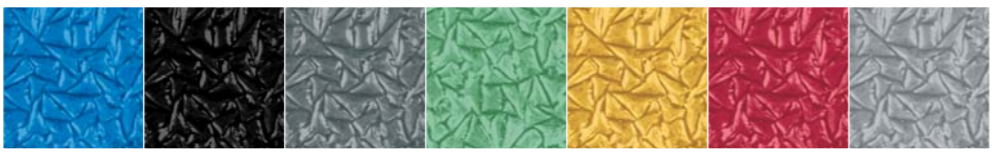
Front of house, shops need floors which can withstand heavy shelving and often heavy traffic. The floors also need excellent light reflection to show the merchandise at its best and to be easy to maintain. Rapid installation may also be important to reduce store closing times during refurbishment work and flooring may be best loose laid.

Back of house areas e.g. stores or even small warehouses can benefit from loose laid solutions and it may be necessary to colour code specific areas to enhance navigation. All floors need to be capable of withstanding both heavy static (shelving) and dynamic (wheeled carts) loads. Safety may also be a consideration if the storage area is to include wet equipment or solutions which may contaminate the floor.

Key selection criteria:

- Good range of contemporary designs and colours to increase interest in products offered for sale
- Good luminescence to increase merchandise visibility
- Hard wearing and resistant to static and dynamic loads
- Loose lay options for rapid installation and minimal downtime
- Noise reduction
- Safety – the HSE have recently increased their concerns with regard to slip accidents and areas where staff may be carrying heavy items need extra care
