The Mystic Washer® is an extraordinary flat surface cleaner that's built in the USA to contractor-grade specifications. Plus, the Mystic Washer® also includes a 'no psi loss' wand attachment that allows fast and convenient washing of either flat or vertical surfaces.

Compared to other pressure washers, the Mystic Washer® is far more efficient and environmentally-friendly for cleaning flat surfaces. Plus, by turning one valve – and without shutting down the power source – the machine becomes a heavy-duty pressure wand system for use on vertical walls. Because there is no long pressure hose needed, you deliver rated pressure from both the wand and the flat surface cleaner!

The Mystic Washer® needs only one person to operate and does the job faster and more thoroughly than other systems. It's a 4000-psi flat surface cleaner *and* a hand-wand all in one unit, and is as easy to run as connecting to a water source and starting the engine.

The Mystic Washer® does a great job with cold water. However, you can operate the Mystic Washer® with soap, as well as add an optional hot water and/or water reclamation system for use in environmentally-sensitive areas and where required.



The Mystic Washer® produces consistent quality and, at the same time, cuts cleaning time by as much as 60% to 80% compared to a standard pressure washer. It also eliminates operator fatigue. Payback for the machine does not take long, since you can out-bid competitors and still make more profit than ever before.

Another advantage of the Mystic Washer® is it may be operated during the day amidst pedestrians and onlookers. Theme parks operate their Mystic Washers whenever they have a beverage spill, weaving right in and around bystanders in lines. Cities can clean their sidewalks and pedestrian pathways in the daytime, during normal working hours. Whenever you need a wand, just turn a switch and activate the built-in, high-pressure wand cleaner.

The Mystic Washer® has been designed to clean flat, vertical and hard-to-reach areas. It is crafted with high quality materials, including stainless steel and aircraft aluminum. Operation is very user-friendly and requires only one person on the jobsite.

Overspray, which is a nuisance and danger common to other pressure washing systems, is a thing of the past. Because there is no back-and-forth action on pavement, such as there is with a hand-held pressure washer, cleaning is even and thorough.

The Mystic Washer® eliminates 'zebra striping' even when the operator overlaps the path. Because there's no pressure loss via the extension hose like with traditional wand-based systems, the Mystic Washer focuses more pressure to get the job done faster. As you can see in the video, your operator will be able to clean most surfaces at a normal walking pace.



Have clients or prospects with wooden decks? The Mystic Washer® offers a variable psi control so you can 'dial it in' for the amount of pressure needed for wooden or other decking. There is no better, easier or more cost-effective way to clean decking than with the Mystic Washer®.

Do you currently use a 'spinner' attachment to your standard pressure washer? Make no mistake: The Mystic Washer® is far superior to a spinner-type unit that attaches to conventional

pressure washers. Pressure is a true 4,000 psi, not whatever is left when long pressure hoses are used to transport the water. In addition, there's no secondary hose to drag around, which means the Mystic Washer® may be operated on a jobsite by just one person. Plus, the highly maneuverable Mystic Washer® is easy to maneuver, and has a pressure wand attached on the side, where it's easy to get to and easy to use.

Mystic Washers are contractor grade, made in the USA, have a one-year limited warranty and are available in 24" and 30" cleaning widths. Frame is made from aircraft aluminum and powder-coated steel, and the machine has pneumatic front casters that are easily adjustable.

The Mystic Washer® is offered with your choice of either a 390cc Honda GX industrial engine or a 404cc Subaru EX-40 Robin engine. The Honda is approximately 13 hp and has a three-year limited warranty. The Subaru Robin is approximately 14 hp and has a [five-year limited warranty](#).

We currently recommend Subaru's very dependable engine, for both its longer warranty and the reasons detailed on the Subaru PDF comparison sheet [located here](#). (Honda has also notified us to expect engine delays in the upcoming months; this may have parts/service availability implications, as well.)

Our water pumps all carry a 5-year limited warranty and are all triplex, plunger-type units with a siphon tube soap injection system. Customers have a choice of having their pumps made by General or Annoli Reveri (AR).

Each Mystic Washer® machine also includes a 6' hose with quick connect/disconnect; 5 spray tips; quick disconnect for extra hose; automatic quick release diverter system to go from Mystic Washer® to spray wand; two swivel front wheels; rear mist deflector; pneumatic "no flat" rear tires; pressure gauge; psi reduction system; ear and eye protection; and, a conventional spray wand.

In a geographical area or situation where you need to contain all the water used during cleaning? The standard Mystic Washer® is available with an optional vacuum containment system. You may also buy the Mystic Washer® with a hot water system, a trailer and/or a water tank feed system. We also offer optional electric start, as well as a variety of specialty spray wand nozzle types.

For dedicated cleaning with water removal, we recommend the [Mystic Washer WR](#) (Water Reclamation) unit, which offers water removal of up to 95%+ during use.
