FIRE HOSE

NFPA 1961, Standard on Fire Hose, 2007 Edition, 5.6.1 "Marking" states: "Each length of fire hose shall be indelibly marked in letters and figures at least 1 in. (25 mm) high with the manufacturer's identification, the country of origin, the month and year of manufacture, and the words "service test pressure to [the service test pressure the hose is designed to] psi (bar) per NFPA 1962 [Standard for the Inspection, Care, and Use of Fire Hose, Couplings, and Nozzles and the Service Testing of Fire Hose]."

COUPLINGS

NFPA 1963, Standard For Fire Hose Connections, 2009 Edition, 4.17 "Marking" states: "...Also, the fire hose connection or fitting shall be permanently and legibly marked on the outside surface of the product, with the country of manufacturing origin."
