SUBSTRATES:

HENRY 546 Feather Edge Additive will bond to the substrates listed. Specific installation recommendations should come from the flooring manufacturer:

- Concrete
- · Primed, poured-in-place gypsum subfloors
- Wood and wood underlayments

INSTALLATION TIPS:

- Condition the area to be installed, adhesive, underlayment, latex, and flooring to 65°F (18°C) or above for 48 hours before, during, and for 48 hours after installation.
- Subfloor must be smooth, sound, dry, clean, and free of dirt, wax, polish, paint, and all other foreign matter which may interfere with a good bond including curing agents and sealers. Concrete must be dry and free of excess alkali.
- Apply with a short nap paint roller or a coarse fiber brush. Do not allow puddles to form or remain on the surface.
- · Use full strength.
- Allow to dry completely, approximately 30 minutes or more.
- Clean tools with water before material dries.
